In order to support students of the region, ICAI also offers a 75% fee waiver for CA course registrations for students from J&K and also plans to set up a Centre of Excellence in the region to boost capacity building, research and skill development, ensuring that young talent in the Valley has pathways to global opportunities.

More than 130 ICAI members and their families participated in the Pahalgam visit, signaling trust in the Valley and inspiring confidence among locals. The delegation's presence resonated as a call for domestic and international tourists alike to rediscover Kashmir as a safe and vibrant destination, essential for the revival of its tourism-driven economy.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of J&K, **Shri Omar Abdullah**, expressed gratitude to convening meeting in the valley and said "Your presence here sends a powerful message of confidence and support. It reflects your belief in this place and reassures our people that better days lie ahead. Winter is not everlasting; spring will come".
